Individual Notes:

Ripley red is confident and self-assured. She shows little to no stress in new situations, around new people, or in circumstances that are typically considered stressful. She reacts appropriately to new sites and sounds, including those that should be considered startling. She is curious and investigative. She has a good memory, focus and problem-solving abilities above average for her age and stage of development. She has excellent motivations for interaction and food. She has a good interest in toys. She is socially appropriate in her interactions with litter mates, cats, and with other dogs. She is also socially appropriate in her interactions with people. She is very gentle with interactions. She rarely uses her mouth and has excellent bite inhibition if she does. She is rarely vocal. Red has mid to moderate energy. The litter overall have no red flags and show no possessiveness. They are comfortable and tolerant of handling and restraint, most of this litter actively seeking out this type of interaction. These puppies are very consistent with very few differences between them that are subtle at best. These differences will become more pronounced as they have different learning and socialization experiences as they grow. This litter is very well balanced. They are content to explore and play on their own, while still being very personable and engaging. They do prefer to be with and around people. They are social, happy, curious, and playful. They are gentle and affectionate. These puppies are well-balanced and should adapt well into most any home, but would do best in homes that are going to be interactive with them.
