Belgium White is confident and self-assured. Although a little immature for her age, it does not affect the results of the test but will delay their go home date. This puppy shows little to no stress in new situations, around new people, or in circumstances that are typically considered stressful. She reacts appropriately to new sights and sounds, and is curious and investigative including those that would be considered startling. White has good memory, focus, and problem-solving abilities average for her age and stage of development. She has very good motivations for food and interactions, and good motivation for toys. This puppy is socially appropriate in her interactions with littermates, with cats, and with other dogs. She is also socially appropriate in her interactions with people. White rarely uses her mouth to initiate or engage in play, but has excellent bite inhibition when she does. She is also rarely vocal. White has mid level energy. She is the most engaging when comparing the litter, and she is a good candidate for therapy work.

Overall, the Belgium litter has no red flags and shows no possessiveness. They are all comfortable and tolerant of handling and restraint. These puppies are fairly consistent with very few differences between them. The differences are noted when comparing them side-by-side. These puppies are all very personable and engaging. They are playful, curious, social, and happy. These puppies are content explore and play on their own without being overly independent. This litter is very well balanced, and should adapt well into most any home.
