Valley Pink overall is very confident and self-assured. She shows no stress to new situations, around new people, or in circumstances typically considered stressful. She reacts appropriately to new sites and sounds. She is curious and investigative. This includes the sights, and sounds, that would typically be considered startling. She has a good memory, focus and problem-solving abilities average for her age and stage of development. She has very good motivation for interaction, food and toys at fairly equal and balanced levels. Pink is socially appropriate in her interactions with one another, cats and with other dogs she is also socially appropriate in her interactions with people. She does use her mouth to initiate or engage in play, but has excellent bite inhibition. She vocalizes during play, but it is easily managed, and or redirected. Pink has no red flags and show no possessiveness. She is slightly more engaging and interactive than her littermates. She can boarder a bit on being pushy. Pink has moderate energy. She is comfortable and tolerant of handling and restraint.

These puppies are fairly consistent with very few differences between them when comparing them side-by-side.
