Individual Notes:

The Kay litter overall is confident and self-assured, they show no stress in new situations around new people are in circumstances typically considered stressful. These puppies react appropriately to new sites and sounds including sights and sounds which could be startling, they are curious and investigative. These puppies overall are motivated by interaction, food, and toys at fairly equal and balance levels. Pink Dot has good memory, focus, and problem-solving abilities average to their age and stage of development. She is socially appropriate in her interactions with people. Pink Dot is rarely vocal and rarely use her mouth to initiate or engage in play. When she does she has excellent bite inhibition. Overall, these puppies are socially appropriate in their interactions with each other, with cats, and with other dogs. Pink Dot has no red flags and shows no possessiveness. She is comfortable and tolerant of handling and restraint. The Kay puppies are very consistent with very few differences between them. Differences are only noted when comparing them side-by-side. They all have mid-level energy. They are all playful, social curious and happy. They are personable and engaging, while still being content to explore and play on their own. None of the puppies are overly independent or aloof. They are very well balanced, and should adapt well into most any home
