The Rosemary litter overall is confident and self-assured. Pink showed no stress in new situations or around new people, or in circumstances that are typically considered stressful. She is curious, and investigative of new sites and sounds, including those should be considered startling. Pink has a good memory, focus, and problem-solving abilities average to his age and stage of development. She has good motivations for interaction, food, and toys at fairly equal and balanced levels. These puppies are socially appropriate in their interactions with one another with cats, and with other dogs, they are also socially appropriate in their interactions with people. Pink is rarely vocal. She rarely uses his mouth to initiate or engage and play, but when she does have very good bite inhibition. Pink has no red flags and shows no possessiveness. The Rosemary puppies are fairly consistent with very few differences between them. They are all comfortable with handling and restraint. Orange Dot has moderate energy. Pink has mid to moderate energy. Pink is playful, curious, happy, and social. She can be silly during play. She is eager and engaging. The Rosemary puppies are content to explore and play on their own, while still being very personable they are fairly gentle with their interactions. These puppies are very, very consistent. Differences will become more pronounced as they mature, and have different learning and socialization experiences these puppies are very well balanced, they will adapt well into most in a home.
