Individual Notes:

The Mulan litter overall is a little timid to start, but they do adjust very well and on their own. They show a little stress in new situations, but no stress around new people, or in circumstances, typically considered stressful like grooming. These puppies are curious and investigating with new sites and sounds, including those that should be considered startling. Overall puppies have a good memory, focus, and problem-solving abilities average to their age and stage of development. These puppies also have very good motivations for interaction and good interest in food and toys. Overall, these puppies are socially appropriate in their interactions with one another, with cats, and with other dogs. They are also socially appropriate in their interactions with people. Blue rarely uses his mouth to initiate or engage in play, when he does he has very good bite inhibition. Blue is rarely vocal. He is comfortable and tolerant of handling and restraint. Blue tends to be very gentle and respectful.

These puppies are fairly consistent with very few differences between them. Differences will become more pronounced as they have different learning and socialization experiences. These puppies are curious, playful, social and happy. They are eager and engaging. They are personable, affectionate, gentle and respectful. These puppies are well balanced, and should do well in most any home that will allow them to adjust to new things without being overwhelmed. They are gentle natured and personable which gives them potential for therapy work, as long as they are appropriately socialized.
