Individual Notes:

The Chevelle litter overall is confident and self-assured. They show little to no stress in new situations, around new people, or in circumstances typically considered stressful. These puppies are curious and investigative with new sites, and sounds, including those that should be considered startling. These puppies have very good memory, focus, and problem-solving abilities above average to their age and stage of development. They have good motivation for interaction, and food. They have good interest in toys. These puppies are socially appropriate and their interactions with one another with cats and with dogs. They are also socially appropriate in their interactions with people. Orange does use his mouth to initiate or engage in play, but he has very good bite inhibition. Orange is rarely vocal, when he does vocalize, it is in socially appropriate situations. These puppies have no red flags and show no possessiveness. Orange is comfortable and tolerant of handling and restraint.

When comparing the Chevelle puppies side-by-side, Blue Dot and Green have moderate energy. The rest of the litter has mid to moderate energy. Blue and Orange are more independent than the rest of the puppies, but they are still personable and engaging. The litter overall is very well balanced. They are personable and engaging. They are eager, affectionate, playful, happy, and curious. Blue and Orange would do better than the rest of the litter in a home that needs to leave their puppy alone a little more often.
