The Ripley litter overall is confident and self-assured, although Green, Blue and Red need a little time to adjust into a

new situation. These puppies show little to no stress in new situations, around new people, or in circumstances typically considered stressful. They are curious and investigative with new sites and sounds, including those that should be considered startling. Even if they startle and react, they do adjust very well, and become curious and inquisitive. These puppies have good memory and problem-solving abilities for their age and stage of development. They also have good motivation for interaction, food and toys at fairly equal and balanced levels. These puppies are socially appropriate in their interactions with one another, with cats, and with other dogs. They are also socially appropriate in their interactions with people. They rarely use their mouth to initiate or engage in play and have very good bite inhibition if they do. They are also rarely vocal. They have no red flags and show no possessiveness. They are all comfortable and tolerant of handling and restraint. Green, Orange and Red have mid-level energy. The rest of the litter has mid to moderate energy. These puppies are curious, playful, social and happy, although a couple need a little time to adjust to new situations. Overall these puppies are very well balanced. They are content to explore and play on their own while still being personable and engaging. They should adapt well into any home. Green, Blue, and Red will do best in a home that will allow them to adjust to new things without being overwhelmed.
