These puppies have excellent memory, focus, and problem-solving abilities above average for their age and stage of development. These puppies have very good motivation for toys and food and excellent motivation for interaction, particularly Orange and Blue Dot. These puppies are socially appropriate in their interactions with one another, with cats, and other dogs. They do use their mouth to initiate and engage in play, but have very good bite inhibition. Blue is very mouthy and likes to always have something in his mouth. These puppies are rarely vocal. They are all comfortable and tolerant of handling and restraint. They have no red flags and show no possessiveness. These puppies are fairly consistent. Blue Dot and Red have mid-level energy. The rest of the litter is mid to moderate. These puppies overall are comfortable and tolerant of handling and restraint. They are all very playful, curious, social, and they are content to explore and play on their own. Orange, Blue, Green, Red, Pink Dot, Pink, White, and Blue Dot would prefer to be with and around people, as opposed to being on their own. These puppies have good potential for therapy work.
