Assessment Notes:

The Faye litter overall is confident and self-assured. They show little to no stress in new situations, whether around new people or in typically stressful circumstances. These puppies are curious and investigative, even with new sights that might be startling. They have good memory and problem-solving abilities, above average for their age and stage of development, especially White and Pink. These puppies are highly motivated by interaction and also have strong motivations for food and toys.

They are socially appropriate in their interactions with one another, with cats, and with other dogs, as well as with people. They are rarely vocal, although Blue can be vocal in socially appropriate circumstances; this is easily managed and redirected. These puppies show no red flags and exhibit no possessiveness. They are all comfortable and tolerant of handling and restraint. They use their mouths to initiate and engage in play but

have excellent bite inhibition. These puppies have moderate energy and are bubbly, happy, social, and eager. Pink, White, and Blue would prefer to be with people but are still content to explore and play on their own. They are very personable, engaging, eager, and interactive.

They all have good potential for therapy work and very good potential for work in general. Pink and Blue also have potential for service work. Pink, White, and Blue will do best in a home that is interactive with them. The rest of the litter is well-balanced and will do well in almost any home.
