Individual Notes:

The Norvina litter overall is confident and self-assured. They show no stress in new situations, around people, or in circumstances typically considered stressful. White and Red do react to sounds that are startling, but do recover very

quickly and on their own. Blue, Green, and Pink are curious and investigative of sights and sounds, including those that should be considered startling. Overall, White, Blue, and Green have very good focus for their age and stage of development. Red and Pink have average focus for their age and stage of development. White, Blue, Red, and Pink problem-solving abilities are above average. Memory-wise, White, Blue, Pink, and Red are also above average, while Green has average memory. These puppies overall have good motivations for interactions, food, and toys at fairly equal and balanced levels. These puppies overall use their mouth quite a lot to initiate or engage in play but have very good bite inhibition. White is vocal in socially appropriate situations, but it is easily managed and redirected; the rest of the litter is rarely vocal. These puppies overall have no red flags and show no possessiveness. They are all comfortable and tolerant of handling and restraint. They have mid-level energy. These puppies are very well-balanced. They are content to explore and play on their own while still being very personable and engaging. These puppies are fairly consistent with differences between them; Green is slightly less mature than the rest of the litter. Some of the results with regard to memory, focus, and problem-solving abilities will adjust with his maturity level. These puppies are all playful, curious, and happy. They are well-balanced and adapt well into most any home.
