When she is exposed to a stressor like a bath or medical treatment, she shows minimal signs of stress.

When Tilly Pink was introduced to noises or startling sounds, she noticed the sound and slowly moves toward to investigate, tail up.

She was investigative when new objects were introduced and would slowly move towards to investigate, tail up. She is a little more confident with what she sees rather than what she hears.

Tilly Pink is showing good focus that lasted up to 15 seconds. Very good for learning and training!

She also has a high interest in higher valued rewards, which is another motivator for good training.

She loves food and enjoys toys as well...

She, along with several of her siblings are motivated to problem solve, and are persistent to try and figure things out.

She is not very mouthy, but will use her mouth about half the time when trying to investigate something new.

During the test, she was vocal in stressful & socially appropriate situations.

She showed good control over the pressure of her bite when exploring with her mouth. Leaving no marks on skin or damage to toys.

When handled she was comfortable and tolerable of restraint.

She demonstrated no possessiveness with her siblings or the tester with toys or food.

Overall, the Tilly litter has a mid-moderate energy level. She is motivated to interact and figure things out with little to no signs of stress in the process. She enjoys playing on her own, but has times of trying to engage with the tester.
