In typically stressful circumstances, these puppies do startle but are able to recover on their own when exposed to new sights and sounds. These puppies were overall nervous but remained engaged and did not run away or panic—they were simply frozen. White began to adjust sooner than the others, but the rest will likely follow with time and with training to help build their confidence. All of them currently show mid-level energy, but as their confidence increases, many elements of this test may change. We recommend that these puppies go to homes that will allow them to adjust to new things at their own pace, without being overwhelmed.

Overall, the puppies scored lower on the interactive scale due to their current insecurity. However, many of these behaviors are likely to improve with increased confidence and maturity over time. We recommend enrolling these puppies in training before they arrive home to work on building their confidence.
