Blair Girl Temperament Overview:

The Blair litter is slightly immature in development, with many puppies still getting their teeth and showing physical traits more in line with 5½ to 6 weeks of age rather than seven weeks. This does not affect the results of the temperament test.

These puppies are confident and self-assured, showing little to no stress in new situations, around unfamiliar people, or in environments typically considered stressful. They are curious and investigative when encountering new sights and sounds, including those that might typically be considered startling.

This litter demonstrates very good memory, focus, and problem-solving abilities—above average for their age and stage of development. They have excellent motivation for interaction and food, as well as strong motivation for toys. Socially, they are appropriate with one another, with cats, with other dogs, and with people. They may use their mouths to initiate or engage in play but have very good bite inhibition. They are rarely vocal, show no red flags or possessiveness, and are comfortable and tolerant of handling and restraint—most actively seeking out this type of interaction.

Overall, the Blair girls are sweet, personable, and well-balanced, with subtle differences between them. They should adapt well into most any home environment.
