They are highly motivated by interaction and food and have very good motivation for toys as well.

Socially, they are appropriate in their interactions with one another, with cats, with other dogs, and with people. While they may use their mouths to initiate or engage in play, their bite inhibition is excellent. They only vocalize in socially appropriate situations and are easily redirected when needed. These puppies have no red flags and show no possessiveness.
