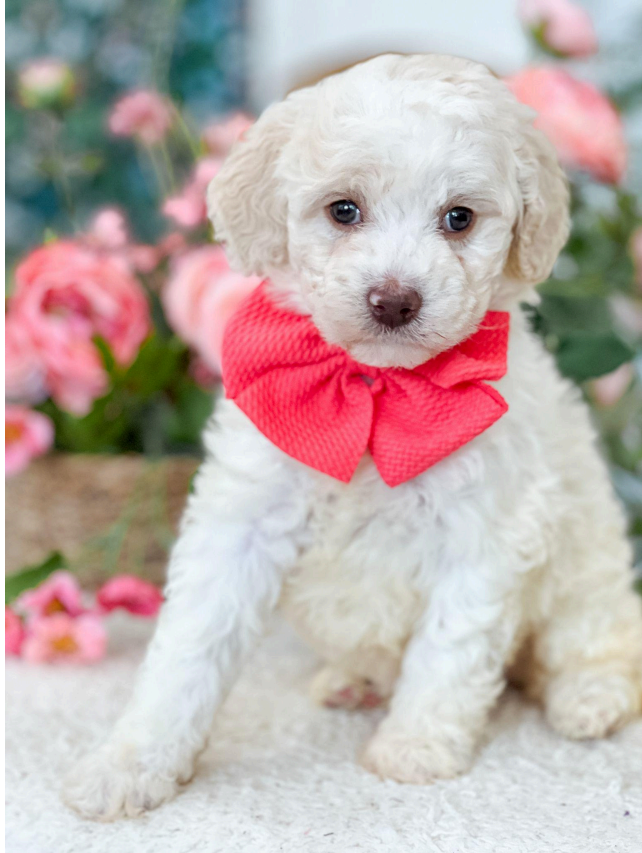

This is a repeat breeding, allowing us to rely on established temperament data from the previous Catalina litter. That group was overall very confident and self-assured, showing no stress in new situations—whether around unfamiliar people or in environments typically considered challenging. They approached new sights and sounds, including those that may be startling, with curiosity and an investigative mindset.

The puppies demonstrated good memory, focus, and age-appropriate problem-solving skills, along with excellent motivation for interaction and strong drive for both food and toys. Socially, they were appropriate and well-mannered with one another, with cats and other dogs, and with people. While they could occasionally be a bit pushy in their eagerness for attention, this was rooted in strong social motivation rather than any negative behavior. Mouthiness during play was present but paired with excellent bite inhibition, and vocalization was minimal. No red flags or possessiveness were observed.

Together, this pairing consistently produces confident, happy, and highly social puppies with strong engagement and people-focused motivation. With their balanced temperaments and adaptability, these puppies show excellent potential for therapy-style work and should transition smoothly into a wide variety of home environments.
